Notice to Exhibitors

The ISWS, its officers and directors and the Silkenfest Committee will not be responsible for dogs or personal property, nor do they assume responsibility for a wrong entry.

Entries: Exhibitors are advised to print all unusual words when filling out entry forms. Entries will be put in the catalogue EXACTLY as they are listed on the entry forms. Owners are responsible for errors in the entry forms. No dog wrongly entered in a class may be transferred to another class after close of entries. No entry may be changed or canceled unless notice of the change or cancellation is received in writing or via email by the Show Secretary as listed in this premium. Entries will not be accepted without the proper signature and fees. Entries must be submitted on approved entry forms, unless they are approved by the Show Secretary as listed in this premium.

No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of any member if the ISWS Board, the Show or Meet Secretary, or any member of the Silkenfest Committee. No entry fees will be returned if the show cannot open or be completed by reasons beyond

the control of the management. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to, snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat or cold, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators. The well-being of dogs, exhibitor and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the show before completion, no refund of entry fees will be made.

Declination of Entries: The International Silken Windhound Society and the Silkenfest Show Committee reserve the right to decline or remove any dog due to disease, viciousness, or other cause and no one shall have any claim against the aforementioned club, committee, or any official thereof. No refund of any entry fees will be made.

Exhibitor Responsibilities: All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crates while on the premises. It is expressly understood that the exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. **Each Owner and Agent** listed on the entry form and/or individual responsible for the dog at a show is bound by the Agreement below as well as the policies Purina Farms has set forth for the use of their facilities and found on page 5 of this premium regardless of who may have completed and submitted the entry form. **The Club, Show Secretary, their Agents, and Employees** assume no responsibility for injury to dogs or attendees. **The ISWS, its officers and directors and the Silkenfest Committee will not be responsible for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, attendees' dogs or property. Judges will not wait** for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the ring when their classes are called to be judged.

No Smoking under any show tent. Crates are not allowed under judging tents, nor or spectators, attendees, or photographers. Please remember to turn off cell phones and/or pagers before entering the ring.

No Personal Photography during Winner's Portraits following Conformation and Performance events.

Agreement

I/we agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I/we agree to hold the ISWS, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents, event secretaries and committee members, as well as the owner/lessee of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, including judges, secretaries, and stewards, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I/we personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; I/we further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I/we hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself/ourselves, or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in

consequence of my/our participation in this event, however such injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. **I/we agree that any cause of action, controversy or claim arising out of or related to the entry, exhibition or attendance at the event between the ISWS and the Silkenfest Committee, and myself/ourselves or as to the construction, interpretation and effect of this agreement shall be settled by arbitration pursuant to the applicable rules of the American Arbitration Association.**

Purina Farms Policies and Directions

Parking

Parking is permitted on black top and gravel lots. During large events, grassy areas may be authorized for parking and will either be marked or someone from the host club will direct guests to an authorized area.

Canopies and Tents

Canopies and tents are permitted on and around parking areas outside the fenced-in show field. Canopies can also be set up on gravel areas inside the show area. During large events, we ask that exhibitors be considerate of others and use only the minimal space they require. Please no tenting or exercise pens on the show fields.

Crating

Crating is allowed ringside 15 minutes prior and 15 minutes after the scheduled class in which handlers and their dogs are competing. Exercise pens are allowed on all parking areas. Grassy areas outside the show field can also be used.

Vendors

Vendors should check-in with the organizing club when they arrive on the grounds. At that time, vendors will be given directions on set-up and parking.

Waste

Containers are placed throughout the grounds. White barrels are for paper trash and brown barrels are for pet waste. Complimentary plastic gloves are provided for your convenience at these locations. There is also designated relief areas set up for dogs to use. PLEASE PICK UP AFTER YOUR PET.

Show Field

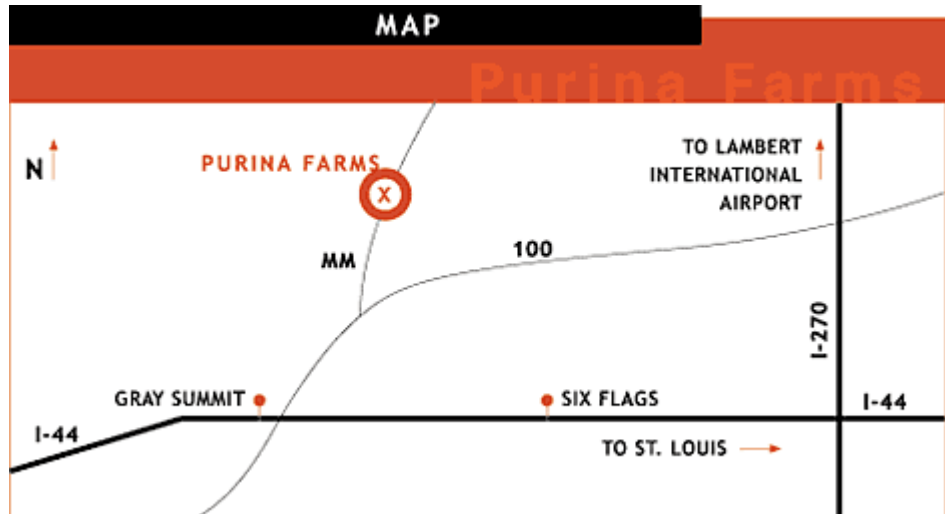
The show field is designated as all grassy areas inside the green fence.

Eligibility:

Only purebred Silken Windhounds may be entered. All entries shall be individually registered with International Silken Windhound Society. All entries must be at least 1 year of age on trial date. Spayed or Neutered Silken Windhounds may compete in any stakes for which there are eligible. Hounds must be 7 years of age or older to compete in Veterans Stake.

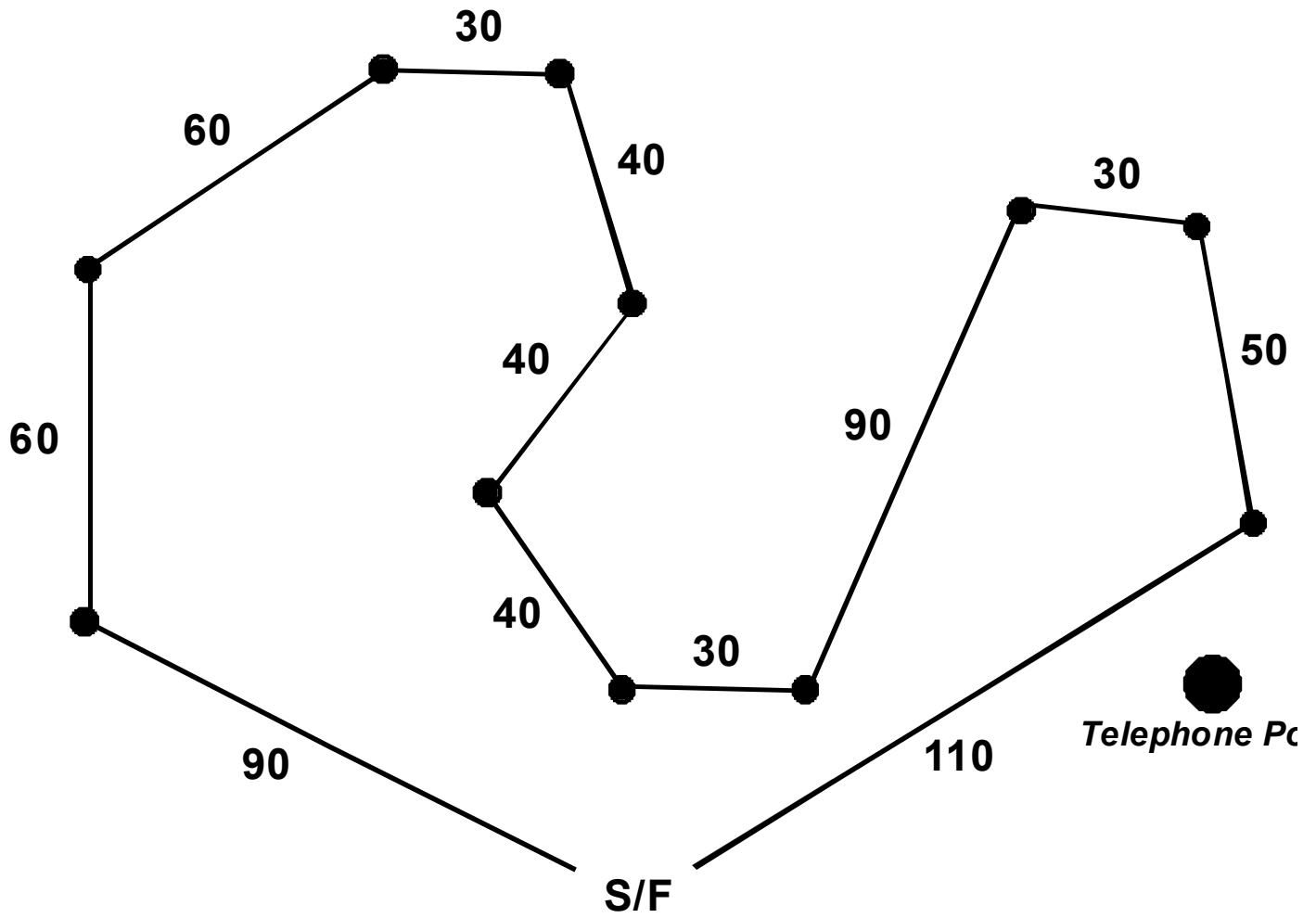
Incomplete, unsigned, conditional, or received after April 27th 2009 entries will not be accepted. Eligible substitutions are allowed for lame or in-season hounds until completion of Roll call and Inspection.

Stakes

Open	Any Eligible Silken Windhound who has met certification Requirements (ISWS CQ Certification or ISWS Racing Championship SRC.) A copy of hounds CQ Certificate, SRC Certificate, or Grading Guide copy containing SRC title is required at their first trial.
