Exhibitors are advised to follow their veterinarian's recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccination. Please note: ***A copy of your current rabies vaccination should be available.***

### Accommodations

Our host hotel, with 30 rooms available, is the Baymont Inn in Battle Creek just off I-94, not downtown. Negotiated room rates are \$109 for a single King room and \$120 for a double Queen room. They also have a \$10 flat fee (not per pet or per day) for pets. To obtain this room rate, please mention SilkenFest when you make your reservations by calling 269-979-5400.

Baymont Inn—4725 Beckley Road, Battle Creek, MI 49017. From the Kalamazoo/Battle Creek International Airport take I-94 East to Exit 97 to Capital Avenue South. Turn right at Beckley Road (first stoplight), then west one block. The hotel is 20 minutes and 18.7 miles away from the Expo Center via I-94 W.

We also have 30 rooms reserved at the Travelodge down the road from the Baymont Inn. This hotel is clean and offers a more economical rate. A single room is \$54.99 and a double is \$59.99. When you make your reservations by calling (269) 979-1828, please mention SilkenFest to get this rate. Travelodge—5395 Beckley Rd, Battle Creek, MI 49015. Directions from Kalamazoo Airport, I-94 take exit 97 to Capital Ave. Turn Left on Beckley Rd. Hotel is 1/2 mile on Left.

The Baymont is within walking distance of a Cracker Barrel, Burger King and a Denny's. The Travelodge is next to a Bob Evans, Fazoli's, Wendy's and many others. Both hotels are within a 1/4 mile of each other. Both are just off the highway, easy on - easy off. Both about 20 minutes from the UKC Premier at the Expo Center.

### RV Parking

If you are planning on driving an RV to SilkenFest, be aware that you have many choices of campsites. **The Kalamazoo Expo Center** has three camping areas at the fairgrounds with a total of 206 campsites. All sites have water and electric. The bathrooms and showers have been recently renovated. Sites are assigned as you arrive; they won't reserve a specific campsite. Therefore, we can't get Silken owners all together.

In the UKC Premier information booklet on the UKC website, there is a form to reserve a spot. Or, you can call and make a reservation. They prefer you reserve your spot with your entry fee. **The phone number is (269) 383-8778.**

If you make your reservations over the phone by May 30th it is \$25 a night. After May 30th it becomes \$30 a night. There is a onetime \$5.00 for all advance reservations. The campground will open at 3:00 on Monday June 10th. NO EARLY ARRIVALS.

If you can't make SilkenFest, you can get a full refund, minus the \$5.00, before May 30. After that there is no refund. They said request for sites will be considered on a first come basis. If there are a few campers that want to be together maybe you can give your info to one camper and that person can make the reservations. Send them your info and money. There is a map of the area on the Kalamazoo Expo web site and also in the premium packet on the UKC web site.

There are 2 dump stations with potable water. Onsite septic service available by pre-registration at \$15 a dump. Dumps can be scheduled for Thursday, June 13, Saturday, June 15, or both days.

*There are four other camping areas, each approximately 13 miles from the fairgrounds:*

- 1) **Coldbrook County Park** (269) 746-4270. They have 29 sites with electric and water, and 15 rustic sites. The sites with water and electric are \$20 a night and the rustic sites are \$15. For both there is a \$5 advance fee for with reservations.
- 2) **Markin Glen County Park** (269) 383-8778. They have 38 modern sites, water, sewer and 50 amp electric. \$25 a night with an unspecified advance registration fee.
- 3) **Fort Custer Recreation Area** (269) 731-4200. They have 219 sites, with only electric, for \$21 a night.
- 4) **Oak Shores Resort Camp Ground** (269) 649-4689. They have 65 campsites with full hookups. Fifty, 30, and 20 amp electric is available. Call for prices. Well behaved pets are welcome.

#### Nearby Airports

The nearest major airport is Kalamazoo/Battle Creek International Airport (AZO/KAZO). This airport has domestic flights and is 6 miles from the center of Kalamazoo, MI. Another major airport is Gerald R. Ford International Airport (GRR/KGRR), which has international and domestic flights from Grand Rapids, Michigan and is 53 miles from Kalamazoo, MI.

Class changes and cancellations must be received in writing prior to closing time. After closing, the only changes which can be made is to move a dog, which has finished its championship, from the Regular class to BOB. This must be done a half hour prior to the start of the show.

*All entry forms must be signed and must include the Agreement and Notice to Exhibitors; otherwise the entry cannot be accepted and will be returned.*

## Dog Show Classification

### Regular Classes

*The following classes will be provided for both dogs and bitches*

\*Puppy classes (\$20/entry vs. \$25) are for those puppies that will be of age on the day of the show, not at the time of entry.

### Non-Regular Classes involving Single Dog Entries for both dogs and bitches

Veteran 7–10 years	Veteran over 10 years
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**Companion** — Open to all neutered and spayed dogs as well as intact dogs 6 months of age or older. Dogs and bitches will be judged separately and winners will not be eligible for Best of Breed judging. No championship points will be awarded. First place in each sex will compete for Best Companion.

ISWS Champions of Record, Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, and each Veteran Class Winner only, will be able to compete for Best of Breed

### Non-Regular Classes involving Multiple Dog Entries

As the judge's decision in the following classes is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won in these classes. The Stud Dog or Brood Bitch must appear in the ring with the get or produce and be entered in the class. The owner of the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch does not need to be the owner of the get or produce. The award is based on the merits of the get or produce.

**Stud Dog Class** — For dogs that have sired two dogs or bitches entered in this show.

**Brood Bitch Class** — For bitches that have whelped two dogs or bitches entered in this show.

**Brace** — Is defined as two dogs of the same breed that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs must be owned by the same owner. Entries in this class must be intact (no spayed or neutered animals). Entries in the Brace class do not have to be entered in any regular class. The entry is not required to be composed of the same sex dogs. Class shall be judged on 40% conformation, 40% matching looks, and 20% difficulty of the match.

### Special Awards

**Award Of Merit** — The AOM will be given at the discretion of the judge immediately after the selection of Best of Breed, Best of Winners, and Best of Opposite Sex,. The number of Awards of Merit will be determined by the total entry at the show.

**Best Puppy in Regular Classes** — Will be selected from the Regular Puppy Class winners following the judging of Best of Breed competition. Only dogs not defeated in a Puppy Class are eligible to compete. If the winner of a class is not present for judging of Best Puppy, the 2nd place in the class may not take its place. If Best of Winners or Best of Breed is from the Puppy Class, it is automatically the Best Puppy in Regular Classes.

**Best Companion** — Will be selected from the Companion Class winners following Best of Breed competition.

**Best Bred-by Exhibitor** — Will be selected from the Bred-by-Exhibitor class winners following Best of Breed.

**Best Veteran** — Will be selected from the Veteran class winners following Best of Breed. If Best of Breed is from the Veteran class, it is automatically Best Veteran in Show.

**Obedience Classes** — Novice A and Novice B

**Rally Classes** — Rally Novice A and Rally Novice B

### Junior Handler

A Junior Handler (Junior Showmanship) shall be at least 9 years of age and no older than 18 years of age. Any dog shown in any Regular or Non-Regular class including any spayed or neutered dog, may be shown in the Junior Handler Class, except that the Junior Handler must own or co-own the dog, or the dog must be owned or co-owned by a member of the Junior Handler's immediate family. We are also offering a Junior Handler Class, with no entry fee, for children 2 years of age and older, but under 9 years of age. For the purposes of this section, the members of an immediate family are: father, mother, brother, sister, uncle, aunt, grandfather or grandmother, including corresponding step and half-relations, or by a permanent member of the Junior Handler's household.

### Versatility

A versatility rosette is being offered for the dog scoring the highest across the three venues of obedience or rally (designate which one you want to be used for versatility before judging starts), lure coursing and conformation. It is necessary to be entered in three events to be in contention for the award. In obedience, or rally-obedience, and lure coursing the individual scores of the dogs will be added. For conformation a separate class for versatility will be judged with different armbands all versatility dogs are judged together in this additional class. The raw score will be given by the judge, based on the breed standard having a perfect score of 100, and the dogs will be ranked according to the raw score received.

### Sweepstakes

#### ***Puppy Sweepstakes***

The Puppy sweepstakes is open to all Silken Windhounds who are 3 months of age and under 18 months of age on the day of the show. Dogs 6 months of age and older shown in Sweepstakes must also be entered in one of the June 15, 2013 regular classes at the regular entry fee for that class. Indicate your sweepstakes Class with the age division on the entry form under Additional classes. Champions of record may not be entered in Sweepstakes. *The age of a dog shall be calculated up to and inclusive of the first day of a show.*

*The following classes will be provided for both dogs and bitches:*

Puppy 3-6 months	
Junior Puppy 6-9 months	Senior Puppy 12-15 months
Junior Puppy 9-12 months	Senior Puppy 15-18 months

#### ***Veteran Sweepstakes***

The Veteran Class shall be for dogs that are seven years of age or older the day of the show. The Veterans Class will be further divided into two age groups consisting of **[seven years and under ten years]** & **[ten years and older]**. The age of a dog shall be calculated up to and inclusive of the first day of the show. Dogs shown in Sweepstakes must also be entered in one of the June 15, 2013 regular classes at the regular entry fee for that class.
