Room rate: \$129.95 plus taxes. Dogs are not allowed throughout the hotel itself we are all in the dog area and our rooms will have direct outside entry. There are dog walking areas with poop bags provided, a dog washing room towels and shampoo are provided.

There are limited rooms at this rate for Tuesday June 7, 2022. The SF lower rate extends until June 14, 2022.

HOTEL ETIQUETTE & RULES

1. **Hotel** - The exhibitor assumes the entire responsibility and liability for losses, damages, and claims arising out of exhibitor's activities on the hotel premises and will indemnify, defend and hold harmless the Hotel, its agents, servants, employees, and the ISWS from any and all such losses, damages, and claims.
2. **Grooming** – We are lucky that both Purina Farms and Holiday Inn have bathing facilities. There is a special Dog Grooming Building at the host hotel. Dogs **must NOT be bathed** in the guest rooms and room towels must not be used for drying dogs. Please bring your own towels, shampoo/conditioner, etc.
3. **Exercise Area** – Our host hotel is very gracious about letting us walk our dogs around their property. The grounds committee will provide plastic bags and waste containers. You must pick up after your dogs at all times. There will be a \$10 **per occurrence** penalty for not picking up after your dog. All monies collected will go to the Silkenfest General Fund. Do not exercise your dog at entrances, in front of or on the hotel building itself and in posted non-dog areas. Do not let your dog relieve itself on plants and shrubs. (This applies to Purina Farms also.)
4. **Guest Rooms** - All unattended dogs must be crated. Please bring sheets or blankets if you allow dogs on the beds.
5. **Damages** - Any and all damage done by dogs is the responsibility of the owners. The ISWS will assist in the collection of damages, if necessary.
6. **Room Care** - Maids will come in to service the rooms daily. As many of us will be in and out each day, the maids will honor the Do not Disturb sign. If maid service is declined on multiple days (using the Do Not Disturb sign), the hotel may set a time to inspect the room.
7. **Checkout** - Checkout time is before 11:00 a.m. If you need alternate arrangements, please arrange directly with the front desk.

REGISTRATION AND ENTRY FEES

ALL SWEEPSTAKES, CONFORMATION, UKC OBEDIENCE and RALLY OBEDIENCE entries MUST BE received by 8:00 p.m. CENTRAL TIME on MAY 1, 2022. NO EXCEPTIONS. After that time, no entries for these events may be accepted, cancelled, changed, substituted, completed or signed and no entry fees will be refunded for these events. Telephone entries are not accepted. Class changes and cancellations must be received in writing prior to closing time. After closing, the only changes which can be made are to move a dog which has finished its Championship, from a REGULAR class to the BEST OF BREED class **OR** to move a dog from an INTACT class to an ALTERED class. This change **MUST BE DONE** at least one half hour before the start of the show, and preferably, well before then. **PLEASE remember that any "AGE CLASS" entries are based on the age of the dog on the DAY OF THE SHOW, not at the time of the registration.**

All entry forms must be signed, electronic signatures are acceptable, and must be on the Official SilkenFest 2022 Entry form. Entries that are not received on this form, including the Agreement and Notice to Exhibitors, will not be accepted and will be returned to the exhibitor.

THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS to the above entry deadline. No "DAY OF EVENT" entries will be taken for any conformation event or for the UKC Obedience and Rally Obedience Trials, with the exception of JR. HANDLER I & II which are allowed to enter on the day of the event.

NATIONAL SWEEPSTAKES JUDGE

Sandra Moore

I first became involved in purebred dogs in 1985 when I purchased my first Borzoi.

Over the years I began to participate in most all events from conformation to obedience to open field coursing with my Borzoi. I have bred over 110 AKC Borzoi with prefix championships and many more with companion and other titles. I am a platinum breeder of merit (which requires not only a number of AKC champions and titlists but proof of health testing for many years) for Borzoi with AKC and I have a provisional AKC judging license to judge Borzoi at AKC dog shows.

I've been an ASFA and AKC lure coursing judge for almost 20 years. I've never seen a reason to separate form from function and most of my champions also have performance titles. In 2015 a bitch from a litter of mine that I co-bred won BOB at the Borzoi National and her sister won an Award of Merit.

In 2004 I judged the National Specialty at Silkenfest and became enamored with the breed. I've owned them ever since. In 2015 a Silken I bred was BOB at Silkenfest in Florida, another Silken I bred was BOW at Silkenfest and a third one I bred was BOB at the Silkenfest National ASFA trial. I have bred a number of ISWS champions and UKC champions and grand champions over the 17 years I've been involved in Silkens and I am looking forward to judging all the beautiful puppies and veterans that attend Silkenfest.

NATIONAL PUPPY & VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

Puppy Sweepstakes is open to all Silken Windhounds who are at least three (3) months of age and under eighteen (18) months of age **on the day of the show**. Please ensure your entry is marked for the AGE the dog will be on the date of the event, not at the time you submit the entry. **The following classes are offered for both dogs and bitches:**

Puppy 3 - 6 months
Junior Puppy 6 - 9 months
Junior Puppy 9 - 12 months
Senior Puppy 12 - 15 months
Senior Puppy 15 - 18 months

Veteran Sweepstakes is open to dogs that are seven (7) years of age or older **on the day of the show**. Please ensure your entry is marked for the AGE the dog will be on the date of the event, not at the time you submit the entry. **The following classes are offered for both dogs and bitches.**

Veteran 7 years to Under 10 years
Veteran 10 years to Under 13 years
Veterans 13+ years of age

Division of Entry Money as Prizes: Thirty five percent (35%) of the total entry fees for the Sweepstakes will be retained by ISWS for expenses. The remaining sixty five percent (65%) of the entry fees will be divided for each class as follows:

NATIONAL SPECIALTY JUDGE

Wayne Cavanaugh

I'm fortunate to be a third-generation dog fancier. My grandfather bred Kerry Blue Terriers and my father bred setters and hounds. My wife Cheryl and I bred and exhibited Pointers, English Setters, Beagles, and an Irish Wolfhound with a focus on function, health, temperament, and breed type. I began judging in 1990 and have since judged hound and sporting breeds in the USA, Canada, Ireland, Japan, and Mexico.

I served as President of the United Kennel Club from 1999 to 2014. During that time, in 2010, I was introduced to Silken Windhounds and reached out to ISWS. I attended my first Silkenfest in Calistoga, CA in 2011, and fell in love with the breed. Seeing the quality in both conformation and performance events was refreshing; soon after, I was honored to recognize the Silken Windhound as a new breed to UKC.

Before my tenure at UKC, from 1991 to 1997, I served as Vice President of the American Kennel Club and represented the United States at the World Congress of Kennel Clubs in Bermuda and Ireland. As a lifelong advocate for the health and function of purebred dogs, I was privileged to be a Charter Board Member of the AKC Canine Health Foundation. For more than 20 years, I served as a television commentator in the USA and England at many major dog events and appeared on Animal Planet, The Today Show, CBS This Morning, Good Morning America, CNN, Fox, ABC, NBC, and CBS News on behalf of purebred dogs.

The National Specialty will be split into two days as follows:

Intact Males: 3 – 6 Months through Winner's Dog Selection and Veteran Males	Stud Dog, Brood Bitch & Brace

The following classes are offered in our National Specialty and are divided by sex. (Please see below for class descriptions.)

- * Puppy & Veteran classes are based upon the age of the puppy on the **DAY OF THE SHOW**, not at the time of entry.
- ** Eligibility for this class requires proof of a championship title for straight racing (ISWS or LGRA), lure coursing (ISWS or ASFA) or open field coursing (NOFCA or other recognized open field coursing association) be submitted at the same time as the show entry.

Regular Class (Not divided by sex)

Best of Breed

To enter Best of Breed via entry, a dog or bitch **MUST BE** an ISWS Champion at the time the entry is submitted. In addition to ISWS Champions, Winner's Dog, Winner's Bitch, Best Veteran Dog and Best Veteran Bitch will compete for Best of Breed.

Non-Regular Class (Not divided by sex)

Altered Best of Breed

To enter Altered Best of Breed via entry, a dog or bitch **MUST BE** an ISWS Altered Champion at the time the entry is submitted. In addition to ISWS Champions, Altered Winner's Dog and Altered Winner's Bitch will compete for Altered Best of Breed.

Non-Regular Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries

A judge's decision in the following classes is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, therefore, no first placements in these classes are eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won in these classes.

STUD DOG - BROOD BITCH CLASS – Open to dogs or bitches that have sired or whelped two or more dogs or bitches entered in the show. A minimum of 2 and a maximum of 4 progeny may be shown in the class. The Stud Dog or Brood Bitch must appear in the ring with the progeny and be entered in the class. The owner of the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch is not required to be the owner of the progeny. The award, although given to the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch is based upon the merits of the offspring.

BRACE CLASS – A brace is defined as two dogs of the same breed that are similar in appearance, performing in unison and presented by a maximum of one handler. This class is judged 40% of conformation, 40% on matching looks, and 20% on difficulty of the match. Entries in this class **are not required to be intact, to be the same sex or to be entered in any regular class.** Both dogs **must** have one common owner.

CONFORMATION CLASS DESCRIPTIONS FOR PURPOSES OF DETERMINING WHICH SPECIALTY CLASS TO ENTER

Regular Classes for Intact Dogs and/or Bitches

6 - 9 Month Puppy - For puppies that are at least 6 but less than 9 months old on the date of the show.

9 - 12 Month Puppy - For puppies that are at least 9 but less than 12 months old on the date of the show.

12 - 18 Month - For dogs at least 12 months of age and less than 18 months old on the day of the show that are not ISWS Champions.

Novice -- This class is for dogs (except ISWS champions) 6 months of age or older that have not yet won (a) 3 first-place prizes against competition in the Novice Class or any ISWS, UKC or ICKC class, (b), 3 or more points towards their ISWS championship or (c) have earned a championship from another venue (UKC or ICKC) prior to the date of the closing of entries.

Bred By Exhibitor - The Bred By Exhibitor class has the following requirements:

- Six months of age or older on the date of the show.
- Not a champion of record in ISWS on the date of the show.
- Must be owned or co-owned by any of the breeders of record on the date of the show.
- Handler must be a breeder of record and an owner/co-owner of the entered dog. (In any subsequent classes for which the dog becomes eligible there are no handler restrictions.)

American Bred - For all dogs, except ISWS champions, who are 6 months of age or over that were bred and whelped in the U.S.

Field Performance – For any dogs, except ISWS champions that have earned a performance championship from LGRA, NOTRA, ASFA or NOFCA. A copy of the dog's title certificate must be submitted with the dog's entry.

Open - For any dogs 6 months of age or older.

Best of Breed - For all ISWS Champions of record.

Non-Regular Classes for Dogs and/or Bitches

3-6 Month Puppy - For puppies at least 3 months but less than 6 months old on the date of the show.

Altered Novice - This class is for all altered dogs (except ISWS or Altered ISWS champions) 6 months of age or over that have not yet won (a) 3 first-place prizes against competition in the Altered Novice Class or any ISWS, UKC or ICKC class, (b) 3 or more points towards their Altered ISWS championship or (c) have earned a championship from another venue (UKC or ICKC) prior to the date of the closing of entries.***

Altered Open - For any altered dogs (except ISWS or Altered ISWS champions) 6 months of age or over.***

Altered Best of Breed – For all ISWS Altered Champions of record.***

Veterans – There are three age classes, separated by sex:

7 years of age to 10 years of age,
10 years of age to 13 years of age, and
13 years of age and over.

Both Veteran Dog and Veteran Bitch winners will compete in Best of Breed. Intact and altered dogs/bitches can be shown either in a “pointed” class or Veterans but not both, i.e. a dog cannot be entered in both Open and Veterans. Similarly, a dog cannot be entered in an “altered” class and also entered in Veterans.

*** In the event that your altered dog was neutered via a vasectomy, please provide a copy of the Veterinarian’s certificate with your entry.

ADDITIONAL AWARDS

BEST OF OPPOSITE SEX – Is determined from the entries in the Best of Breed ring that are the opposite sex to the entry awarded BEST OF BREED.

BEST OF WINNERS – Is determined between the Winner’s Dog and Winner’s Bitch. If the Best of Breed is either the Winner’s Dog or Winner’s Bitch, that entry is also awarded Best of Winners.

AWARD OF MERIT – Awards of Merit will be given at the discretion of the judge immediately after the selection of Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex and Best of Winners. The number of Awards of Merit will be determined by the total number of valid Regular Class entries.

BEST VETERAN – Shall be selected from the Veteran class winners following the Awards of Merit. If Best of Breed is from the Veteran class, it is automatically Best Veteran in Show. The remaining Veteran will be awarded Best of Opposite Sex to Best Veteran in Show.

BEST BRED BY EXHIBITOR – Shall be selected from the Bred by Exhibitor Class winners following Best Veteran. The remaining Bred by Exhibitor will be awarded Best of Opposite Sex to Best Bred By Exhibitor.

BEST PUPPY IN REGULAR CLASSES – Will be selected from all Puppy Class winners from the 6 – 9 and 9 – 12 month classes following the judging of Best Bred By Exhibitor competition. Only dogs not defeated in a Puppy Class are eligible to complete. If Best of Winners or Best of Breed is from the Puppy Class, it is automatically the Best Puppy in Regular Classes.

JUNIOR HANDLER

Junior Handler and Junior Showmanship Classes – There are two separate age ranges for each of these class designations.

Junior Handler I class is for handlers at least two (2) years of age, but under four (4) years old. Parent or other adult must be in the ring and may assist with handling.

Junior Handler II class is for handlers at least four (4) years of age, but under eight (8) years old. Parent or other adult must be in the ring and may assist with handling.

Junior Showmanship I class is for handlers at least eight (8) years of age, but under twelve (12) years old.

Junior Showmanship II class is for handlers at least twelve (12) years of age, but under eighteen (18) years old.

Juniors may show any dog entered in any Regular or Non-Regular class, including any spayed or neutered dog. All Junior Handler & Junior Showmanship entries are exempt from the pre-entry requirement and may enter up to and including the day of the show. The Junior Handler I & II classes are offered at no cost.

ANY JUNIORS ENTERING DAY OF SHOW MUST DO SO BY 7:00 A.M. ON THE DAY OF THE EVENT.

It is the owner's responsibility to ensure the accuracy of the information on their entries. Please make every effort to check your dog's titles, spelling, DOB, etc. as these catalogs are an important archive of breed information and history. Owners are responsible for any errors on those forms. Please note that entries will be listed as stated on the entry forms. If you are unsure of information regarding your dog's information, please contact Charliann Cross, the ISWS Registrar. Please ensure that your entry is legible.

ARCHWAY IRON HOUND

An Archway Iron Hound rosette & award will be presented to the dog scoring the highest across the three venues of: Lure Coursing, Straight Racing and Oval/Uval Racing. There is no cost for entering this competition, however, an indication must be made on the dog's Entry Form that it is entering this competition.

ARCHWAY HOUND TRIATHLETE

An Archway Hound Triathlete rosette & award will be presented the dog scoring the highest across three venues, including: The National Specialty, Lure Coursing and Straight Racing or Oval/Uval Racing. There is no cost for entering this competition, however, an indication must be made on the dog's Entry Form that it is entering this competition.

ARCHWAY HOUND PENTATHLETE

An Archway Hound Pentathlete rosette and award will be presented to the dog scoring the highest across five of the six offered venues. The National Specialty (sweepstakes class is not eligible) and lure coursing must be included as part of the five venues, with Obedience, Rally Obedience, Straight Racing, or Oval Racing comprising the other three scores. There is no cost for entering this competition, however, an indication must be made on the dog's Entry Form that it is entering this competition.

MORE INFO REGARDING ARCHWAY HOUND COMPETITIONS

The dog's best scores across the venues will be tabulated. A dog entering the triathlon may enter both straight racing & ovals. The best three scores will be used. The same is applicable to the pentathlon competition. The dog's best five scores will be used in the calculations. There are six competition options.

The "National Specialty" conformation process will be determined in a separate judging class and does not require an entry fee. Example: All dogs entered in an Archway Hound Triathlete or Pentathlete competitions will enter the ring together and the conformation judge will assign number placements for each

dog with #1 being the closest to the breed standard and continuing until all dogs have been ranked with a number. Please note that since the dogs entered in this selection process will be in the ring with others that may not have been in the ring at the same time previously, their prior placements, whether in the Sweepstakes or National Specialty have no bearing on the placements in this selection.

In the event of a tie in any of the Archway Hound competitions, each of those hounds will have earned the distinction and both will receive the recognition and award. In the event that the necessary additional awards are not available at the awards determination, they will be shipped to the hound's owner.

ISWS ANNUAL MEETING

The annual meeting of the ISWS Membership will be at Purina Farms on Friday, June 10, 2022, with the exact location being determined at that time.
