The Dog Clubs that are participating in the Oklahoma Summer Classic **reserves the right to remove any individual from the premises for reasons of health and safety.** Any violations/infractions of the below listed behavior will be considered reasons for removal under this provision.

THE FOLLOWING BEHAVIOR IS PROHIBITED:

- Behavior that is unruly, disruptive or illegal in nature.
- Abusive, foul or disruptive language and obscene gestures

Due to the popularity of this show, reserved space will sell out quickly. Please only reserve as much space as you may need. One space per Reservation Form. **Electric is only available for reserved grooming spaces**. No electric is provided nor available to open grooming.

THERE WILL BE NO CRATES OR TABLES ALLOWED WHATSOEVER IN THE CONFORMATION JUDGING AREAS, UNLESS PERMITTED BY SHOW COMMITTEE. NO SOFT-SIDED CRATES ALLOWED RINGSIDE, OR IN THE OPEN GROOMING AREAS. ALL CRATES MUST BE STACKABLE. NO unentered dogs allowed at these shows. Vendors may request an unentered dog pass.

Grooming area set-up is under the supervision of the BUILDING AND GROUNDS COMMITTEE who may require rearrangement of exhibitor set-ups where space is not properly used.

Open grooming in the building is limited to designated areas & is available on a first-come, first-served basis.

NO EXERCISE PENS IN OPEN GROOMING.

Crated dogs will be allowed in the building overnight at owner/agent's risk. Neither the Show Superintendent nor Kennel Clubs will be responsible for any dogs or equipment. **Each Crate containing a dog in the building overnight must have a tag attached to it with the name, location & phone number of the person responsible for that dog.**

There will be on-site dog bathing facilities & expanded public exercise pens.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning their grooming area. The Show Committees will tour the grooming area after Groups each day & messy areas will be tagged. Continued grooming area violations can result in your grooming area privileges being suspended.

The Show Committee reserves the right to require the stacking of crates, limiting the use of exercise pens & grooming tables & any other remedies it may deem necessary for space & the safety of all in non-reserved & reserved spaces on a case-by-case basis at their committee's discretion.

The safety & welfare of all dogs is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor. It is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor that no dogs are left unattended on grooming tables.

The Show Committees reserve the right to remove exercise pens anywhere in or around the building if not maintained. **Private exercise pens are allowed in the reserved grooming area only.** Any sawdust or paper used in exercise pens must remain clean & odor free. Regular Classes for Dogs and Bitches

- 1. **Puppy 6 to 9 months:** This class is for puppies (except champions) 6 months of age and over, but under 12 months. A dog's age shall be calculated up to and inclusive of the 1st day of a show. A dog is ineligible if it has turned the limiting age on the 1st day of the show.
- 2. **Puppy 9 to 12 months:** This class is for puppies (except champions) 9 months of age, but under 12 months. A dog's age shall be calculated up to and inclusive of the 1st day of a show. A dog is ineligible if it has turned the limiting age on the 1st day of the show.
- 3. **Twelve to Eighteen months:** This class is for dogs (except champions) 12 months of age and over, but under 18 months. A dog's age shall be calculated up to and inclusive of the 1st day of a show. A dog is ineligible if it has turned 18 months of age on the 1st day of the show.
- 4. **Novice:** This class is for dogs 6 months of age or older that have not yet won 3 first-place prizes in the Novice Class, a first-place prize in the Bred-By-Exhibitor Class or Open Class, or 3 or more points towards their ISWS championship prior to the date of the closing of entries.
- 5. **Bred-By-Exhibitor:** This class is for dogs (except champions) that are: (a) 6 months of age or over on the date of the show, (b) owned or co-owned by any of the breeders of record on the date of the show and (c) handled by a breeder/owner or breeder/co-owner of record on the date of the show. There are no handler restrictions in any subsequent classes for which the dog becomes eligible at the show.
- 6. **American-Bred:** This class is for all dogs (except champions) 6 months of age or over that have been both bred and whelped in the United States of America.
- 7. **Open:** This class is for any dog (except champions) 6 months of age or over.

Winners: NOTE, this is not a class you enter. Dogs with a first-place win from a regular class move into this class and compete for the available points. This class is for those undefeated dogs of the same sex that have won first-place from any of the regular classes listed above. After the Winners prize has been awarded in one of the sex divisions, the dog that won second place to Winners in its regular class, if undefeated except by the dog awarded Winners, shall compete with other eligible dogs for Reserve Winners. No eligible dog may be withheld from competition.

 - a) Dogs that are ISWS champions of record; b) Winners Dog and Winners Bitch of the event.

SECTION 3 — **Conditions Affecting Eligibility of Dogs** No entry may be made, and no entry shall be accepted by a Show Secretary which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.

- 1.Any Silken Windhound shall be eligible to be entered in an ISWS show if it meets one of the following conditions: a) the dog is individually registered and entered into the ISWS Stud Book; or b) the dog is part of an ISWS-registered litter that has been assigned a Litter Number.
- 2.Any Silken Windhound that is part of an ISWS-registered litter with a previously assigned Litter Number may be entered in an ISWS show. Such a dog will remain eligible to enter additional ISWS shows for 30 days after the date of the first show in which the dog was entered. The dog must be individually registered with the ISWS during that 30-day period.
- 3. If the dog is not individually registered with the ISWS during that 30-day period, any points, majors, or championships earned may be lost unless the owner of the dog can clearly demonstrate (in writing to the ISWS Show Recorder and the ISWS Registrar) that the delay in registration is due to circumstances beyond the control of the owner.

Closing Date: All entries must be received by the Show Secretary by June 14th. Entries will be listed in the catalog exactly as they are listed on the entry form. Owners are responsible for providing correct and legible information, including the correct titles, on their entries. 



Listed below are a few of the more popular attractions:

Bricktown - East of the fairgrounds, downtown

Renovated warehouse district, which is now Oklahoma City's hot spot featuring many restaurants and night spots, as well as the Bricktown Canal and the SBC Bricktown Ballpark, home of the Oklahoma City Dodgers.

Frontier City Theme Park – 1-35 North, Exit 122nd Street; (405) 478-2412

Stroll through an authentic 1880s western town and enjoy over 75 rides, shows, games and attractions. Four thrilling coasters, the Renegade Rapids river raft ride, the perilous Tomahawk and MindBender, and the Mystery River Log Flume. Try The Hangman, a thrilling freefall ride!

Myriad Botanical Gardens - 100 Myriad Gardens; Reno & Robinson; (405) 297-3995

The Myriad Botanical Gardens is a 17-acre oasis in the heart of downtown Oklahoma City, with beautifully landscaped rolling hills surrounding a sunken lake. The centerpiece of the gar- dens is the seven-story Crystal Bridge Tropical Conservatory, featuring a fascinating collection of palm trees, flowers and exotic plants from across the globe. And, dog park located here!

National Cowboy and Western Heritage Museum – 1700 NE 63rd; (405) 478-2250

The National Cowboy and Western Heritage Museum preserves the rugged individualism and romantic spirit of the frontier. This popular visitor attraction features a superlative collection of classic and contemporary Western art, including works by Charles Russell, Frederic Remington, and the famous 18-foot sculpture, The End of the Trail. There are three new historical galleries, the American Cowboy Gallery, the American Rodeo Gallery, and Prosperity Junction, a recreated authentic western town.

Oklahoma City Museum of Art - 415 Couch Drive, Main. (405) 236-3100

The new Oklahoma City Museum of Art in the Donald W. Reynolds Visual Arts Center is a 110,000 sq. ft. facility featuring 15 exhibitions galleries, an education center, a 250-seat theater, cafe, store and library/resource center. The commissioned 55 ft. signature sculpture by world renowned glass artist Dale Chihuly serves as a beacon for the museum, and downtown.

Oklahoma City Zoo - 2101 N E 50th; (405) 424-3344

Oklahoma City Zoo is home to over 1,500 of the world's most exotic animals, including over 50 endangered or threatened species. Enjoy dramatic views of the world's most exotic animals in naturalistic settings like Great EscApe, Cat Forest/Lion Overlook and The Noble Aquatic Center.

Science Museum Oklahoma - 2100 NE 52nd; (405) 602-OMNI

Science Museum Oklahoma is an adventure in discovering new worlds and galaxies, exploring the sciences and arts, reliving the past and peering into the future. The complex houses several museums, a planetarium, galleries, gardens and greenhouses. Several museums are all located in the Science Museum Oklahoma, including the Kirkpatrick Science and Air Space Museum, Red Earth Indian Center, and the International Photography Hall of Fame and Museum.

Remington Park Race Track – 1-44 and Martin Luther King Blvd.; 800-456-9000

State of the art racetrack featuring world-class racing, restaurants, gift shops, arcade for kids.

Water Taxi of Oklahoma - On the Bricktown Canal; (405) 234-TAXI

A most unique attraction on the new Bricktown Canal. Water Taxi runs a continual service like a bus. You can board a Water Taxi every 10-15 minutes in either direction. Water Taxi Ambassadors narrate points of interest along the way. Purchase tickets from kiosk, located in Bricktown Oklahoma Avenue on the canal.
