

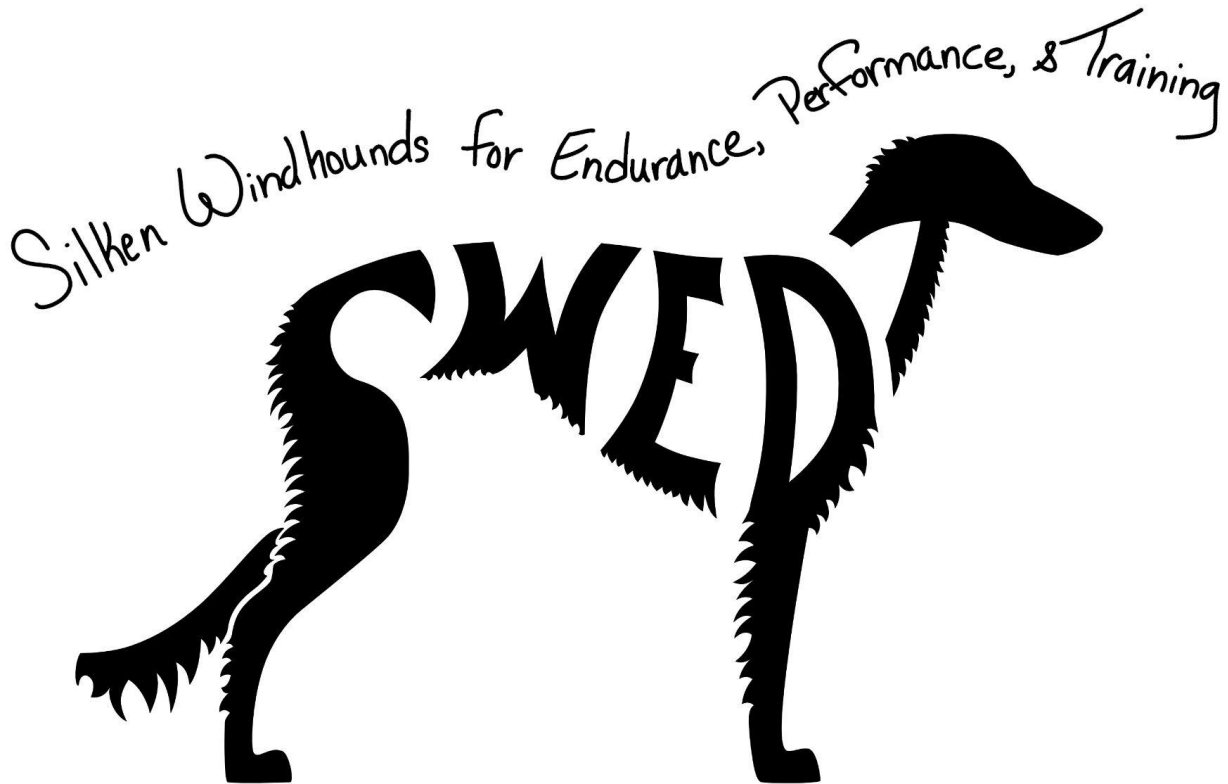

This is private property and by agreeing to come to this show/race in any capacity you are agreeing to absolve Paul and Karen Sanders, Allagante Silkens and SWEPT from any responsibility including, but not limited to, any and all loss, damage, or injury to or by any dog, person or property.

## Declination of Entries

SWEPT and/or Paul and Karen Sanders (owners of the property the event is being held at) reserve the right to decline to accept and/or remove any dog due to disease, viciousness, or other cause and no one shall have any claim against the aforementioned club, committee or owner for such action. No refund of any entry fees will be made.

## Exhibitor Responsibilities

**Dogs** - All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crates/pens while on the premises unless racing or coursing or unless given permission by the property owners. It is expressly understood that the exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Each owner and Agent listed on the entry form and/or individual responsible for the dog at the show/race is bound by the Agreement below regardless of who may have completed and submitted the entry form. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners, handlers or agents are responsible for the presence of the dog in the ring when their classes are called to be judged. This means it is not the responsibility of the ring steward, show secretary or any other volunteer to make sure a dog is present in the ring at the required time.

**No Smoking** - No smoking is allowed outside of your personal vehicle. Please do not smoke in any building, pastures or fields

# Registration & Entry Fees - Conformation

## Conformation Entries Must Be Received by Saturday, June 10th, 2023 by 9pm PST

*THERE WILL BE NO "DAY OF" CONFORMATION ENTRIES*

After that time, no entries may be accepted, canceled, changed, substituted, completed or signed, and no entry fees refunded. Telephone entries not accepted. Class changes and cancellations must be received in writing prior to closing time. After closing, the only change which can be made is to move a dog, which has finished its championship, from the Regular class to BOB. This must be done a half hour prior to the start of the show.

**All entry forms must be signed (an electronic signature is acceptable) and must include the Agreement and Notice to Exhibitors; otherwise the entry cannot be accepted and will be returned.**

**All entries will be put in the catalog exactly as they are listed on the entry form. Owners are responsible for errors on the entry forms.**

# Conformation Show Classification

Determining which specialty class to enter

There are different kinds of classes in every ISWS Specialty show. There are Regular (6-9 Month Puppy, 9-12 Month Puppy, 12-18 Months, Novice, Bred By Exhibitor, American Bred, Field Performance, Open, and Best of Breed) and Non-regular (Veteran, Altered, 3-6 Month Puppy, Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, and Brace) classes in addition to Junior Handler and Showmanship.

All of the regular classes are available for both dogs and bitches. Dogs are judged first, followed by bitches, preceded or followed by various non-Regular classes.

Below are descriptions of all of the classes so that you can determine where you wish to enter your dog(s).

## Regular Classes - Dogs and Bitches

**Puppy 6 - 9 months:** For puppies that are at least 6 but less than 9 months old on the date of the show

*\*First place will compete for Best Puppy in Show*

**Puppy 9 - 12 months:** For puppies that are at least 9 months but less than 12 months old on the date of the show

*\*First place will compete for Best Puppy in Show*

**12 - 18 months:** For dogs at (except ISWS champions) least 12 months of age and less than 18 months old on the day of the show

**Novice:** For dogs (except ISWS champions) 6 months of age or older that have not yet won:

- 3 first place prizes against competition in the Novice Class or any ISWS, UKC or ICKC class
- 3 or more points towards their ISWS championship
- have earned a championship from another venue (UKC or ICKC) prior to the date of the closing of entries

**Bred-by-Exhibitor:** For dogs (except ISWS champions) 6 months of age or older that meet the following requirements:

- Six months of age or older on the date of the show
- Not a champion of record in ISWS on the date of the show
- Must be owned or co-owned by any of the breeders of record on the date of the show
- Handler must be a breeder of record and an owner/co-owner of the entered dog

*\*In any subsequent classes for which the dog becomes eligible there are no handler restrictions*

**American Bred:** For dogs (except ISWS champions) 6 months of age or older that were bred and whelped in the U.S.

**Field Performance Champion:** For dogs (except ISWS champions) that have earned a performance championship from LGRA, NOTRA, ASFA, or NOFCA

**Open:** For dogs (except ISWS champions) 6 months of age or older

**Winners:** This is not a class you enter. The Winners Class is for the Winners of the previous 8 classes to compete for Best Male and Best Female.

**Best of Breed:** For all ISWS Champions of record as well as Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, Veterans Dog, and Veterans Bitch.

## Non-Regular Classes

**3-6 Month Puppy:** For puppies at least 3 months but less than 6 months old on the date of the show.

**Altered Novice:** For altered dogs (except ISWS or Altered ISWS champions) 6 months of age or over that have not yet won:

- 3 first-place prizes against competition in the Altered Novice Class or any ISWS, UKC or ICKC class
- 3 or more points towards their Altered ISWS championship
- have earned a championship from another venue (UKC or ICKC) prior to the date of the closing of entries.

**Altered Open:** For any altered dogs (except ISWS or Altered ISWS champions) 6 months of age or over

**Altered Best of Breed:** For all ISWS Altered Champions of record

**Veterans:** For all dogs/bitches 7 years or older

*\*Note: Both Veteran Dog and Veteran Bitch winners will compete in Best of Breed. Intact and altered dogs/bitches can be shown either in a "pointed" class or Veteran's but not both, i.e. a dog cannot be entered in both Open or Altered Open and Veterans.*

## Non-Regular Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries

A judge's decision in the following classes is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, therefore, no first placements in these classes are eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won in these classes.

**Stud Dog/Brood Bitch Class:** For Stud Dogs or Brood Bitches that have produced 2 or more dogs/bitches entered in this show. A minimum of 2 and a maximum of 4 progeny may be shown in the class. The Stud Dog/Brood Bitch must appear in the ring with the progeny. The owner of the Stud Dog/Brood Bitch is not required to be the owner of the progeny. The award, although given to the Brood Bitch, is based upon the merits of the offspring.

**Brace:** A brace is defined as two dogs of the same breed that are similar in appearance, performing in unison and presented by a maximum of one handler. This class is judged 40% on confirmation, 40% on matching looks, and 20% on the difficulty of the match. Entries in this class are not required to be intact, to be the same sex or to be entered in any regular class. **Both dogs must have one common owner.**

## Junior Handler

There are two separate age ranges for Junior Handler and Junior Showmanship class designations.

**Junior Handler I:** For handlers at least two (2) years of age, but under four (4) years old. A parent or other adult must be in the ring and may assist with handling.

**Junior Handler II:** For handlers at least four (4) years of age, but under eight (8) years old. A parent or other adult must be in the ring and may assist with handling.

**Junior Showmanship I:** For handlers at least eight (8) years of age, but under twelve (12) years old.

**Junior Showmanship II:** For handlers at least twelve (12) years of age, but under eighteen (18) years old.

Juniors may show any dog entered in any Regular or Non-Regular class, including any spayed or neutered dog. All Junior Handler & Junior Showmanship entries are exempt from the pre-entry requirement and may enter up to and including the day of the show. The Junior Handler I & II classes are offered at no cost.

**ANY JUNIORS ENTERING DAY OF SHOW MUST DO SO BY 7:30 A.M. ON THE DAY OF THE EVENT.**

**Additional Awards**

**Award of Merit:** Awards of Merit will be given at the discretion of the judge immediately after the selection of Best of Breed, Best of Winners, and Best of Opposite Sex. The number of Awards of Merit will be determined by the total number of valid Regular Class entries.

**Best Veteran:** Shall be selected from the Veteran class winners following the Awards of Merit. If Best of Breed is from the Veteran class, it is automatically Best Veteran in Show.

**Best Bred-by-Exhibitor:** Will be selected from the Bred by Exhibitor Class winners following Best Veteran.

**Best Puppy in Regular Classes:** Will be selected from all Puppy Class winners following the judging of Best Bred-by-Exhibitor competition. Only dogs not defeated in a Puppy Class are eligible to complete. If Best of Winners or Best of Breed is from the Puppy Class, it is automatically the Best Puppy in Regular Classes.

## 8th Annual Oregon Trail

*Sponsored J Vookles of InPhenite Sighthounds*

Crossing the continent to Oregon took a great emotional and physical strength. Pioneers had to have great endurance and a wide range of skills to survive. The hound winning the Oregon Trail Award must demonstrate speed, agility, endurance, and focus. By placing well in conformation, the hound also reflects the beauty of this great region.

This award is for those hounds that compete in one or both ISWS specialties and feel they still have more to give by competing in the LGRA straight racing meet and the ASFA lure coursing trial. To be eligible, hounds must complete all three events, without dismissal or disqualification. Hounds scratched from any event, for any reason, are ineligible for Oregon Trail Hound awards.

**Conformation:** A hound can compete in one or both ISWS Specialty shows. In order to be eligible to compete for the award of the Oregon Trail Hound, you must enter and compete in a special conformation class to be held after the second ISWS Specialty show.

**LGRA:** Entries will be ranked in order of placements relative to the other hounds competing for the award. Each hound is ranked in order of finish.

**ASFA:** Entries will be ranked in order of placements relative to the other hounds competing for the award. For placement the preliminary and final scores will be added together for the dog's total score, regardless of stakes. For tied scores, if those dogs happen to compete in a run off, the winner will receive the lower score. Otherwise the ranks will be averaged (if a dog in Open and FCH stakes were tied for rank 3 with 291 points; rank  $3+4/2=3.5$  points for each. BOB will receive extra 10 points added to their final score before placement.

For example:

Open stake (score):

Rank 1 dog A 303

Rank 4 dog B 297

Rank 5 dog C 295

FCH stake:

Rank 2 dog D 299

Rank 3 dog E 298

Rank 7.5 dog F 290

Veteran Stake:

Rank 6 dog G 292

Rank 7.5 dog H 290

Rank 9 dog I 285

For the tied scores, the 7 and 8 ranks are averaged at 7.5.

Any Ties: If 2 hounds are tied the hound with the lowest single ranking would win. If still tied (i.e. both had a BOB), then the dog with the 2 lowest rankings would win. (Ranks  $1+2+4+6$  wins over  $1+3+3+6$ )

Each entrant's ranks from the three events will be summed. The hound with the LOWEST score will become the first Oregon Trail Hound. For example, a perfect score, earned by the highest ranked dog in each event, would be a 4.
