Show 1 Judge: Corrine Miller, Firebird Borzoi (registered)

I got my first Borzoi in 1982, with a plan for showing and obedience. That bitch was a fantastic companion and though racked up many single and double points, did not finish her championship. We did training through Utility and she had a CDX. She was a great hunter, which set me on the path for coursing, though she did not possess the desire for plastic. A few years later, I bought a bitch from John Cowan, Zephyr's Reach. This girl, Zephyr's Reach Firebird M., CGC, CD, brought the desire for hunting anything - even plastic - to my dogs. Everything I have now is bred down from her. From her, Firebird has produced many champions, Field Champions, ROMs, and BCOA Versatility Award winners. Through my years as an apprentice of the breed, I have learned to value the importance of strong running gear, proper temperaments, and longevity. I hope to continue to learn about Borzoi and other sighthounds. Thank you for asking me to judge your lovely breed!

Show 2 Judge: Sharon Johnson, Azuma Borzoi

Sharon acquired her first two Borzoi in 1995. She co-bred two small litters of Borzoi under the prefix "Azuma" in the early 2000's. Those litters produced 5 AKC BBE champions with several Lure coursing, LGRA and agility titles. Since then, she has owner-handled 5 more Borzoi to their AKC Grand Championships with multiple specialty wins including three Borzoi Club of America National Specialty Awards of Merit, plus multiple other titles. Sharon judged two large regional specialty sweepstakes for the Borzoi Club of Northern California and the Rocky Mountain Borzoi Club. She had the honor of being selected to judge the 2019 Borzoi Club of America Futurity in Gettysburg, PA with an entry of over 40 Borzoi.

"One of the biggest influences on my judging was participating in, with several of my Borzoi, Dr. Anne Midgarden's Borzoi speed study (<http://user.nktelco.net/teine/speed1.htm>) This helped me to better understand the physical characteristics that contribute to a fast and agile sighthound."

I have been in sighthounds (Silken Windhounds and Saluki) for 5 years now, with an emphasis largely on lure and open field coursing. I am the president of a lure coursing club, the Southern Idaho Sighthound Field Association, and have bred several silken windhound litters.

Explanation of ISWS Conformation Classes

Dogs are judged first, followed by bitches, preceded or followed by various non-Regular classes. Winners of each Regular Class compete for: Winners Dog, Reserve Winners Dog or Winners Bitch, Reserve Winners Bitch. Winners dog & Winners Bitch are eligible for Best of Breed Competition. Winners of Best Veteran Dog, & Best Veteran Bitch are eligible for Best of Breed Competition. Winners of 3-6 Month Puppy, Altered, Stud Dog, and Brood Bitch **do not** compete in Best of Breed.

Age of an eligible dog shall be calculated up to and inclusive of the day of the show

Below are descriptions of all of the classes. Use them to determine where you wish to enter your dog(s).

* indicates a non-regular class, no ISWS championship points awarded from these Classes

**Please note you may only enter in ONE class for each dog, with the exception of the Junior Handler and Junior Showmanship classes.

3-6 Month Puppy* — For puppies (except ISWS champions) that are at least 3 but less than 6 months old on the date of the show. (First place in this class will compete for Best Puppy in Show.)

6-9 and 9-12 Month Puppy — For puppies (except ISWS champions) that are at least 6 but less than 12 months old on the date of the show. (First place in this class will compete for Best Puppy in Show and Winners.)

****ONLY First place in each of these classes; non-regular 3-6, 6-12 puppy classes, will compete for Best Puppy in Show. ****

12-18 Month — This class is for dogs (except ISWS champions) that are at least 12 but less than 18 months old on the date of the show. (First place in this class will compete for Winners.)

Bred by Exhibitor — The Bred-By Exhibitor class has the following requirements:

- Six months of age or older on the date of the show
- Not a champion of record in ISWS on the date of the show
- Must be Owned or co-owned by any of the breeders of record on the date of the show
- Handler must be a breeder of record and an owner/co-owner of the entered dog. In any subsequent classes for which the dog becomes eligible there are no handler restrictions. (First place in this class will compete for Winners.)

American Bred — For all silkens (except ISWS champions) 6 months of age or older that have been both bred and whelped in the United States of America. (First place in this class will compete for Winners.)

Field Performance Champion — For all silkens, except ISWS champions, that have earned a performance championship for straight racing, oval racing, lure coursing or open field coursing. Proof of a championship title for straight racing (ISWS or LGRA), oval racing (ISWS or NOTRA), lure coursing (ISWS or ASFA), or open field coursing (NOFCA or other recognized open field coursing association) must be submitted with the show entry. A copy of the championship certificate or a printout from the website of the appropriate organization showing that the dog has earned a championship will suffice as proof of championship title. (First place in this class will compete for Winners.)

Open — For any silkens 6 months of age or older. (First place in this class will compete for Winners.)

Best of Breed — For all ISWS Champions of record (to be joined by Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, Best Veteran Dog, and Best Veteran Bitch).

Veterans 7-10 years* — For all silken 7 years of age to 10 years of age. Neutered or spayed dogs are allowed in this class. (First place in this class will compete for Best Veteran and both Veteran Dog and Veteran Bitch winners will compete in Best of Breed.)

Veterans 10+ years* — For all silken 10 years of age and over. Neutered or spayed dogs are allowed in this class. (First place in this class will compete for Best Veteran and both Veteran Dog and Veteran Bitch winners will compete in Best of Breed.)

Altered Novice* — This class is for all altered dogs (except ISWS or Altered ISWS champions) 6 months of age or over that have not yet won:

- 3 first-place prizes against competition in the Altered Novice Class or any ISWS, UKC or ICKC class
- 3 or more points towards their Altered ISWS championship
- or have earned a championship from another venue (UKC or ICKC) prior to the date of the closing of entries.

Altered Open* — For all altered dogs (except ISWS or Altered ISWS champions) 6 months of age or over.

Best of Altered* — For all Altered ISWS Champions of record, Altered Winners Dog, and Altered Winners Bitch.

Junior Handler*

- a. Junior Handler I class is for handlers aged 2 years to under 4 years (parent or other adult must be in the ring and may assist the Junior Handler)
- b. Junior Handler II class is for handlers aged 4 years to under 8 years (parent or other adult must be in the ring and may assist the Junior Handler)

Junior Showmanship*

- a. Junior Showmanship I class is for handlers aged 8 years to under 12 years.
- b. Junior Showmanship II class is for handlers aged 12 to under 18 years.

The show secretary and show committee have the sole discretion to make an informed decision regarding any class corrections. A dog shown in a class for which it is ineligible will forfeit all wins and prizes associated with such win but will be considered as having competed for the purpose of counting points available. No entry fees will be refunded for such errors.
