## Judge Biographies



### **Jan Leikam AKC#24369**

I acquired my first Borzoi in 1970 after finding an ad in the Seattle Times for “free Borzoi to anyone willing to spay”. I was incredibly naïve and it took me a long time to get past that start.

I began my Judging career in 2003 and currently judge 5 hound breeds, 1 toy breed and all-breed Junior Showmanship.

I was the Show Chair for Sammamish Kennel Club for 20+ years – both Winter Cluster show and our stand-alone Summer all-breed show.

Currently I am living with my husband and 4 Borzoi in Shelton, WA and enjoying retirement.

I try to learn something each time I go into the ring...about the breed I’m judging and/or about myself.



### **Beth Levine**

I got my introduction to sighthounds when I was in high school, after my mother found a stray senior Afghan Hound whose gentlemanly dignity and grace stole my family's hearts.

As an adult, I became involved with Greyhounds in the early 1990s, before settling on Whippets as my breed of choice in 1998. I participate in lure coursing, straight and oval racing, conformation and occasionally obedience

with my homebred whippets under the prefix Serendipity.

I am a working board member of a number of clubs, both locally and nationally, and am the volunteer webmaster for the ASFA Region 1 website.

I am a longtime field trial secretary for both ASFA and AKC lure coursing trials, and have been Field Trial Secretary for both the ASFA II and the AKC NLCC. It has been my honor to judge ASFA, AKC and CKC lure coursing trials around the greater Northwest for over 20 years, and on the national level, I have judged national specialty trials for the American Whippet Club, the Basenji Club of America, the Rhodesian Ridgeback Club of the United States, the Scottish Deerhound Club of America, the Borzoi Club of America, and the Irish Wolfhound Club of Canada.

On the conformation side, I have enjoyed judging numerous CWA conformation matches, including the 2023 CWA National match, and judged both the ISWS specialty show and lure coursing trial at NWFest in 2018. I am honored to have been invited to judge British Columbia and Washington Silken Windhound’s inaugural Snohomish Garden Gala ISWS specialty and look forward to judging your beautiful and athletic hounds.

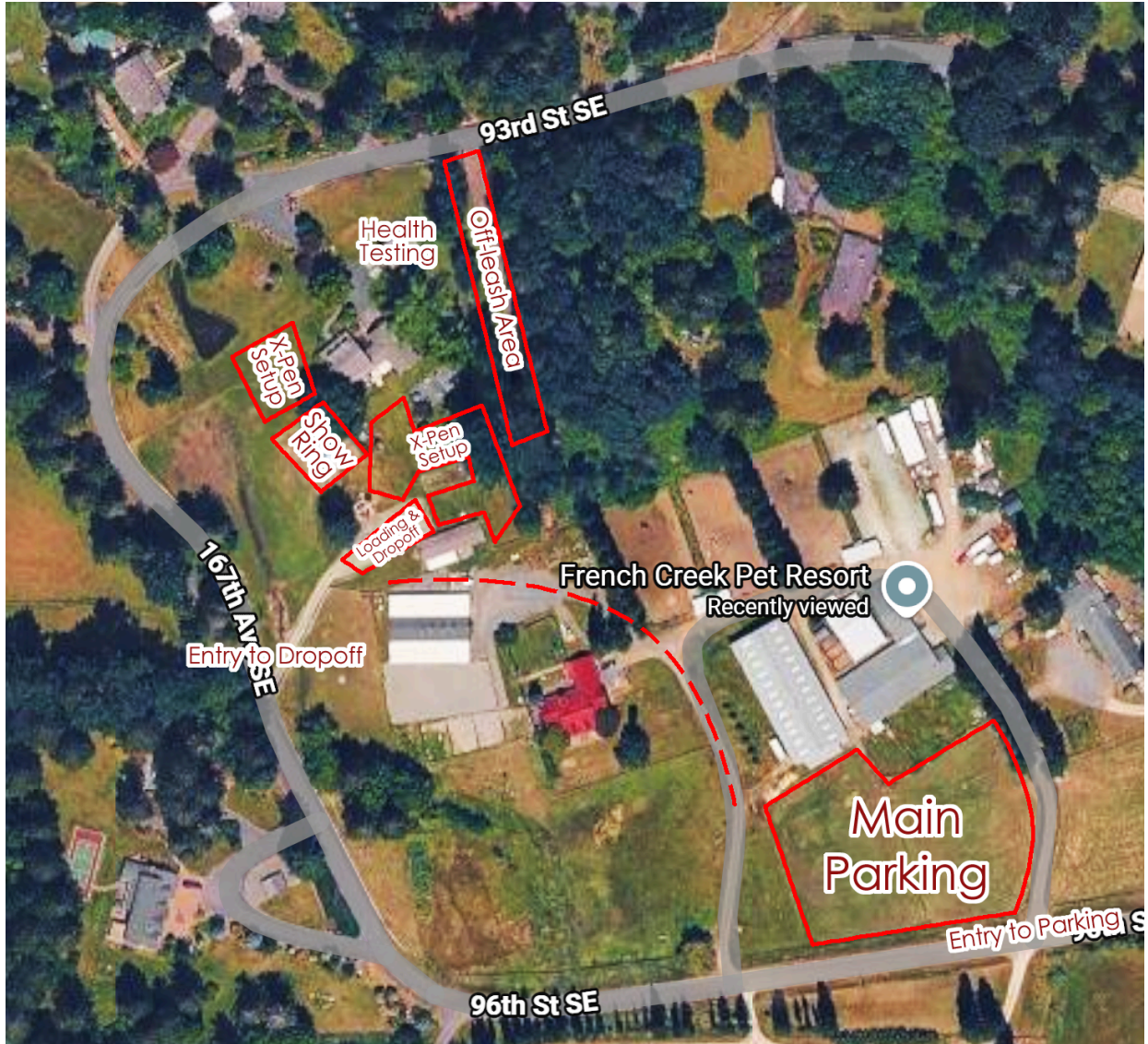

## **ISWS Show Rules rev April 2024**

### **CHAPTER 11 — PRINCIPLES OF GOOD SPORTSMANSHIP**

The ISWS expects its members to practice and uphold the following principles of good sportsmanship in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance, and companion.

As such, ISWS members, exhibitors and judges should:

1. Respect the history, traditions, and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs
2. Commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace
3. Refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior
4. Judge only on the merits of the dogs, and considers no other factors
5. Accept constructive criticism
6. Decline to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dog(s)
7. Refuse to compromise the impartiality of the judge
8. Respect the ISWS Bylaws, Rules, Regulations & Policies
9. Find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors
10. Welcome, encourage, and support newcomers to the sport
11. Share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock
12. Spurn any occasion to take personal advantage of positions offered/bestowed upon them
13. Always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog
14. Refuse to embarrass the sport, the International Silken Windhound Society, or themselves while taking part in the sport

## Appendix: ISWS Speciality Show Class Eligibility

<b>Class Classifications</b>	
The following regular ISWS classes (divided by sex) will be provided:	
Junior Puppy (6-9 mo)	Dogs (except Champions) between 6 months and under 9 months on day of show
Senior Puppy (9-12 mo)	Dogs (except Champions) between 9 months and under 12 months on day of show
12-18 months	Dogs between 12 months and under 18 months on the day of the show that are not ISWS Champions. This class is not eligible for BEST PUPPY.
Novice	Dogs (except champions) 6 months of age or older that have not yet won: (a) 3 first place prizes against competition in the Novice Class or any ISWS, UKC or ICKC class, (b) 3 or more points towards their ISWS championship or (c) have earned a championship from another venue (UKC or ICKC) prior to the date of the closing of entries.
American Bred	Dogs (except champions) 6 months of age or over that have been both bred and whelped in the United States of America.
Bred-by Exhibitor	Dogs (except champions) that are: a. 6 months of age or over on the date of the show, b. owned or co-owned by any of the breeders of record on the date of the show and c. handled by a breeder/owner or breeder/co-owner of record on the date of the show. There are no handler restrictions in any subsequent classes for which the dog becomes eligible at the show.
Open	Any dog (except champions) 6 months of age or over.
Field Performance Champion	All dogs (except ISWS conformation champions) that have earned a performance championship. Proof of a championship title for straight racing (ISWS or LGRA), oval racing (ISWS or NOTRA), lure coursing (ISWS or ASFA) or open field coursing (NOFCA) or other recognized open field coursing association) must be submitted with the show entry. A copy of the championship certificate or a printout from the website of the appropriate organization showing that the dog has earned a championship will suffice as proof of championship title. **
Veteran	For all dogs over 7 years of age on the day of show. These dogs compete for regular placements and the winner of this class will go on to compete for BEST OF BREED (they do not compete for ISWS CH

	Points). Veterans will be divided by age: 7 years old up to 10 years and 10 years old and over. <b>Dogs in this class may be spayed/neutered.</b>
Champion	Dogs who are ISWS Champions at the time the entry is submitted
Brace	A brace is defined as two dogs of the same breed that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of one handler. This class shall be judged 40% on conformation, 40% on matching looks, and 20% on difficulty of the match. Entries in this class are not required to be intact, to be the same sex, or to be entered in any regular class. Both dogs must have one common owner.
Stud Dog & Get	Each entry shall consist of a stud dog with a maximum 3 of his progenies. The stud dog must be shown in the ring with his progeny. The stud dog may be neutered, but the progeny must be intact. The stud dog's owner is not required to own the progeny. All progeny shown in this class must be entered in 1 of the regular classes. The winner of this class is not eligible for Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed competition.
Brood Bitch & Progeny	Each entry shall consist of a brood bitch with a maximum 3 of her progenies. The brood bitch must be shown in the ring with her progeny. The brood bitch may be spayed, but the progeny must be intact. The brood bitch's owner is not required to own the progeny. All progeny shown in this class must be entered in 1 of the regular classes. The winner of this class is not eligible for Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed competition.
Junior Handling	For handlers aged 2 years old to under 8 years old. A parent or other adult must be in the ring and may assist the Junior Handler. The handler may show any dog entered in any Regular or Non-Regular class, including any spayed or neutered dog.
Junior Showmanship	For handlers aged 8 years old to under 18 years old. The handler may show any dog entered in any Regular or Non-Regular class, including any spayed or neutered dog.
Silken Ambassador Showcase	We are proud to honor the work of our Silken Windhound service and therapy dogs as they parade around the ring. Each Ambassador dog will receive a medallion and small prize in appreciation of their service. Sponsored by the Silken Windhound Club of America.
<b>*NEW*</b> Legacy Showcase	BCAWS is proud to offer the legacy showcase class as an opportunity for Silken Windhound breeders to show off their lines over multiple generations. This showcase features groups of three dogs across three generations to display a breeder's lines across many years. Participants in this class will not be judged or receive ribbons.
